## Outings Report

On Saturday, the Patrols tackled

10 different stations in the Field Competition, with tasks ranging from starting fires, tying knots, and teamwork challenges. The afternoon included ax & knife throwing and target shooting at the Mountain Man events. In the



evening, the Troops raced both the weather and other Troops in the Troop relay. The indoor campfire, prompted by foul weather, included some great skits by the Blue Dragons and DaMoose. At the closing

ceremony on Sunday, the Blue Dragons and DaMoose earned two of the six “Presidential” ribbons for their efforts in the Patrol Competition. Troop 166 closed camp by serving as Color Guard.
